








FLORADALEIANS EMERGE WINNERS

























Janmashtami Celebration 2019......














Inter School Volley Ball Match

Students of Class VI to XII visited Science Bus at school premises. In which students enjoyed to the fullest. Students were extremely excited. It was a good learning experience for the students.


























EXCURSION TO GURUDWA PRE PRIMARY 8 Nover




























HOSTED A SEMINAR CUM COUNSELLING SESSION IN COLLABORATION WITH INDIAN NAVY














Basant Panchmi
